



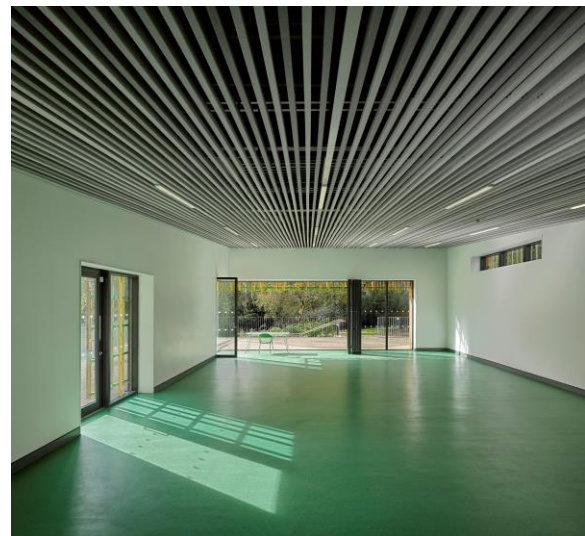

Girlguiding Cheshire Forest purchased an area of woodland in Sandiway in the late 1970s. The land had been left untouched for years. Through hours of volunteer effort, 17 acres have been transformed into a thriving activity centre.

City Build recently completed the first phase of a new building on the site which houses an activity hall and dining room. Phase 2 will see the rest of the building fitted out to include en-suite bedrooms and kitchen.

The design and materials used have been chosen so that the building fits well in the woodland setting. The adaptable design of the new facility has enabled greater use than the existing dated building, particularly to those requiring disabled facilities and mixed groups.

We are presently on site at this 4-star hotel creating a unique and captivating restaurant, bar and lounge. It features glass entrance doors leading into an airy oasis of chic décor and palm trees and a garden room restaurant with coffered metallic leaf ceiling. Mirror panelled walls light the way to the self-serve breakfast bar. There is a glass and steel roof, which covers the entire courtyard area, situated in the heart of the hotel and spa. A careful mix of bronze, aged brass, smoked mirror and Carrara marble fixtures and fittings gently catch the light in contrast to the grounding made-to-match original brick walls.
