

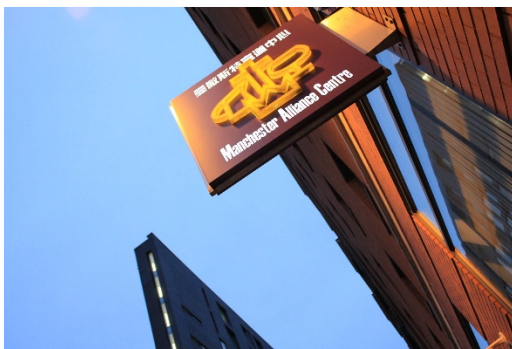

**Value: £248,000**



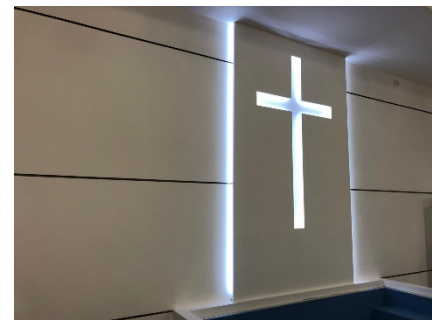
In early 2020 City Build completed an internal refurbishment with extension of a mezzanine floor at this busy church in the centre of Manchester.



We were contracted to provide a new stage, backdrop and associated fittings, a new creche room, fire exit and stairs plus a new multifunction room with minor repairs to other areas of the church.

Whilst the fit-out works were straightforward in nature there was a high level of risk in the project, which our site team mitigated through careful health and safety management. Works to the mezzanine included working at height, which use of cherry pickers, so robust method statements were prepared and delivered, with our key staff and subcontractors being PASMA trained.

The church is based in Manchester City Centre, just off Oxford Road and near to the Mancunian Way. Whilst the church was closed during the project, safety of the public passing the site was of paramount importance. We worked closely with the church and design team to segregate our works with clear demarcation of the site boundary and pedestrian routes around it. Our site logistics plan was followed to the letter, with deliveries scheduled for quieter times and a banksman used in this regard.
